CLARIFICATION NOTE N° 4 of 12 June 2026

With reference to the above-mentioned tender procedure, please find below questions raised by prospective bidders and corresponding answers given by the EUMM

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| 1 | <p>Document in the Tender Dossier “Additional information about the Contract Notice”, page 2</p> <p>During the information meeting, it was stated that the financial documents to be submitted must be in Euros (EUR) and converted using the national exchange rate as of December 31st.</p> <p>However, the "Additional Information" document specifies that the InforEuro exchange rate of May 2026 should be used.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><i>“9. Additional information</i></p> <p><i>Financial data to be provided by the tenderer in the tender submission form must be expressed in EUR. If applicable, where a tenderer refers to amounts originally expressed in a different currency, the conversion to EUR shall be made in accordance with the InforEuro exchange rate of May 2026, which can be found at the following address:</i> http://ec.europa.eu/budget/graphs/inforeuro.html”</p> | <p>Information in the Tender submission form document (Tender dossier document D1), relating to tenderer’s financial information shall be submitted in euro using the historical exchange rate of <i>InforEuro</i> available at http://ec.europa.eu/budget/graphs/inforeuro.html”</p> <p>For your financial turnover calculation in the Section 3 “Economical and Financial Capacity” of the Tender submission form document, please use the date when your respective financial year was closing – e.g. InforEuro GEL-EUR exchange rate of December 2025 if your financial year was closing on 31 December 2025, InforEuro GEL-EUR exchange rate of December 2024 if your financial year was closing on 31 December 2024 and etc.</p> <p>For the previously implemented supply contracts and calculation of their value in euro in the Tender submission form document Section 6, “Experience”, column “Overall supply value, EUR” please use InforEuro GEL-EUR exchange rate of the month and year when your respective contract was concluded (signed).</p> |

However, Euros are appearing here in the tender form document -</p> <p><i>“ D1 Tender form</i></p> <p>3 <i>The price of our tender, excluding spare parts and consumables, if applicable (excluding the discounts described under point 4) is:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>XXX,XXX.XX EUR”</i> <p>– Should we modify this to GEL?"</p> | <p>Reference is made to the tender document D1 Tender form, section 7 “Tenderer’s declaration”, Article 3. <u>Please use GEL</u> in expression of the price of your tender. Therefore the text shall be as follows:</p> <p>“3 The price of our tender excluding spare parts and consumables, if applicable (excluding the discounts described under point 4) is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • XXX,XXX.XX GEL” |
| 3 | <p>Additionally, we would like to ask one more question about the specified average unit price. The text states that we should take the period from 8 June through 18 June (both dates inclusive) and provide the average for 10 calendar days. However, including both dates results in 11 days. Should we calculate and provide the average price based on 11 days?</p> | <p>In the calculation relating to the Financial offer preparation, please use 10 calendar day average unit price per one liter for the days 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of June 2026.</p> |
